St Matthew, Apostle, Evangelist

Matthew's name appears in lists of the twelve apostles of Jesus. According to Matthew's Gospel, Matthew was a tax collector, though Mark and Luke call the tax collector Levi. According to Luke, when he became a follower of Jesus, Levi or Matthew held a feast in Jesus' honour. Nothing else is known for certain about Matthew.

The Gospel that bears his name may originate from a church associated with him, but it owes much also to other proclamations of the gospel message.
