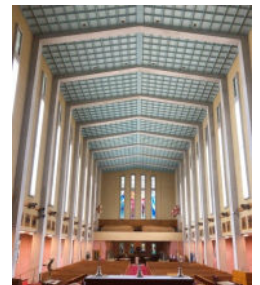


Prayer Chain
