

# Community invited to the Hastings Earthquake Commemoration

Tomorrow, Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> February, is the 94<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the devastating 1931 earthquake which destroyed buildings in Napier, Hastings, and with wider Hawke's Bay region, and with the loss of 256 lives. The Hastings Civic Service will be held at the Clocktower tomorrow commencing at 10.30am, with the tolling of the bells and a minute's silence at 10.47am, the exact time the earthquake began. Members of the public are warmly invited to attend to pay their respects, remember and reflect on the impact of the earthquake and the rebuild that followed. Wreaths will also be laid at the clocktower.
