### **Changes in Clergy Appointments**

Last Monday, Bishop Andrew Hedge shared the news of some upcoming clergy movements within the Diocese:

- \* The Very Reverend Di Woods has resigned from her role as Dean of Waiapu Cathedral where she has served for the past three years. Di will conclude her time in the Cathedral Parish with a Liturgical farewell to be held on Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> May 2025 more details to follow.
- \* The Reverend Linda King has resigned and retired from her role as Vicar/ Superintendent at the Whakatane Cooperating Parish; her farewell will be on Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> June 2025.
- \* The Reverend Alister Hendery completes his ministry with Greater Hastings Parish on Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> April; and has been appointed to the role of Acting-Dean at Waiapu Cathedral, 0.75 FTE, commencing on the 12<sup>th</sup> May, for a period of at least 12 months.
- \* The Reverend Deborah Broome, the Diocesan Ministry Educator, has been appointed as an Associate Priest at Waiapu Cathedral, 0.25 FTE, from the 25<sup>th</sup> May 2025.
