### WELCOME to our services in the Parish this week.

The week we call Holy is rapidly approaching. Beginning with Palm Sunday worship, the procession of the palms & the blessing of the crosses begins our journey through Holy Week. This is a joyous & chaotic event as we remember Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem on a donkey.

At 8.30am on Monday 14, Tuesday 15, Wednesday 16 & Thursday 17 April we will have Morning Prayer in the Lady Chapel of St Matthew's as the story of Holy week unfolds.

This will lead us into the Easter or Paschal Triduum. This is the three days from Holy or Maundy Thursday to Easter Sunday. There are two opportunities to worship on Maundy Thursday, two on Good Friday, Holy Saturday is a day of waiting, and there are three opportunities to worship on Easter Day.

May your Lenten preparations prepare you for the Holy Week to Easter Day journey of worship.

**Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> April:** Maundy Thursday 7pm 'Last Supper' Eucharist and foot-washing



**Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> April:** Low Sunday -Eucharist & Thanksgiving for the Gift of a Child; and Farewell service for The Rev'd Alister Hendery as he completes his ministry in the Parish of Greater Hastings before commencing his new role as Acting-Dean at Waiapu Cathedral. Around 6.3 million people live in the areas most affected by the earthquake, infrastructure, where homes, and essential services have been destroyed. Myanmar state media reports that 1,644 people have lost their lives, with many more injured.

In the spirit of Lent, a season of reflection and sacrifice, we invite you to contribute both financially and in prayer. This Lent, Anglican Missions is focusing on supporting urgent recovery efforts in Myanmar.

## MYANMAR EARTHQUAKE APPEAL


Myanmar has been devastated by a major earthquake. You can support the Anglican response to deliver food, shelter, and medical aid to those in need.
