For anyone who is interested in ways to arrange church flowers with an ecofriendly twist, come along to a demonstration followed by a hands-on workshop.


Please bring a bucket of long-stemmed flowers / foliage from your garden or foraged if you can. You are also welcome to just come and watch the demonstration if you wish.
