


Welcome to our services in the Parish this week.

The Feast of the Ascension is on Thursday 29 May. This is then soon followed by Pentecost which we celebrate on Sunday 8 June, please come in red, orange and yellow colours.

That encouraged them to follow Luke's account of events, in which the lordship of Christ is proclaimed by the description of his ascension in glory to reign over all things. a Professional Development Seminar
