WELCOME TO THE ANGLICAN PARISH

OF GREATER HASTINGS

A very warm welcome if you are visiting, or joining us for the first time, it's wonderful to have you with us; please introduce yourself to one of the Clergy & join us for Morning Tea after worship.

Lent is here! We begin our Lenten Journey on Shrove Tuesday, 17 February, at 6pm for Festive Mardi Gras Pancakes. Then we move to Solemn Ash Wednesday for the Imposition of Ashes. More details on these are in the Newsletter or <https://www.facebook.com/ParishOfGreaterHastings>.

Lent consists of the forty weekdays before Easter. It is a time of preparing & getting in shape to appreciate Easter. Lent is often the period of preparation for Baptism at Easter. The forty days of Lent are based on the story of the forty days Jesus spent in the wilderness when he was tempted. Holy Week & Easter are the pinnacle of this preparation.

Our Parish Study Group meets at 11.15am after Thursday mid-week worship.
